Visa & Entry Requirements

NEW ZEALAND ELECTRONIC TRAVEL AUTHORITY

North Americans traveling to or transiting through New Zealand under the visa waiver program are required to have an NZeTA. This is also true for cruise ship passengers. It can take up to 72 hours to process an NZeTA so apply well in advance of your trip. The NZeTA is valid for multiple visits for up to two years.

NEW ZEALAND TRAVELLER DECLARATION

It is free and everyone travelling into New Zealand needs to complete a declaration.

Complete it online or via the NZTD mobile app before arriving into all international airports in New Zealand including Auckland, Wellington, Christchurch and Queenstown. A paper version will continue to be available for those who cannot complete it online.

June - August Average daytime temperature: 12 - 16°C (53 - 61°F)

March - May Average daytime temperature: 17 - 21°C (62 - 70°F)




ROTORUA
