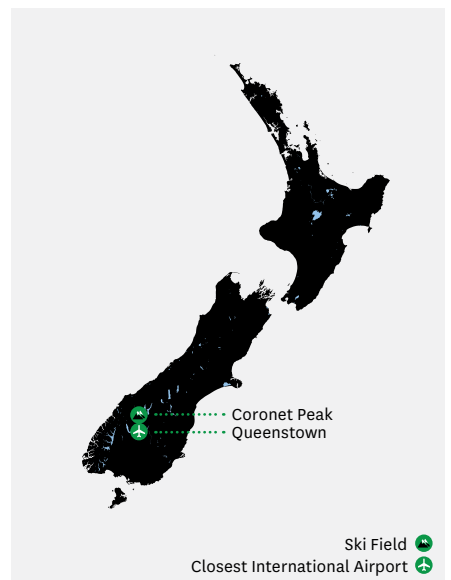


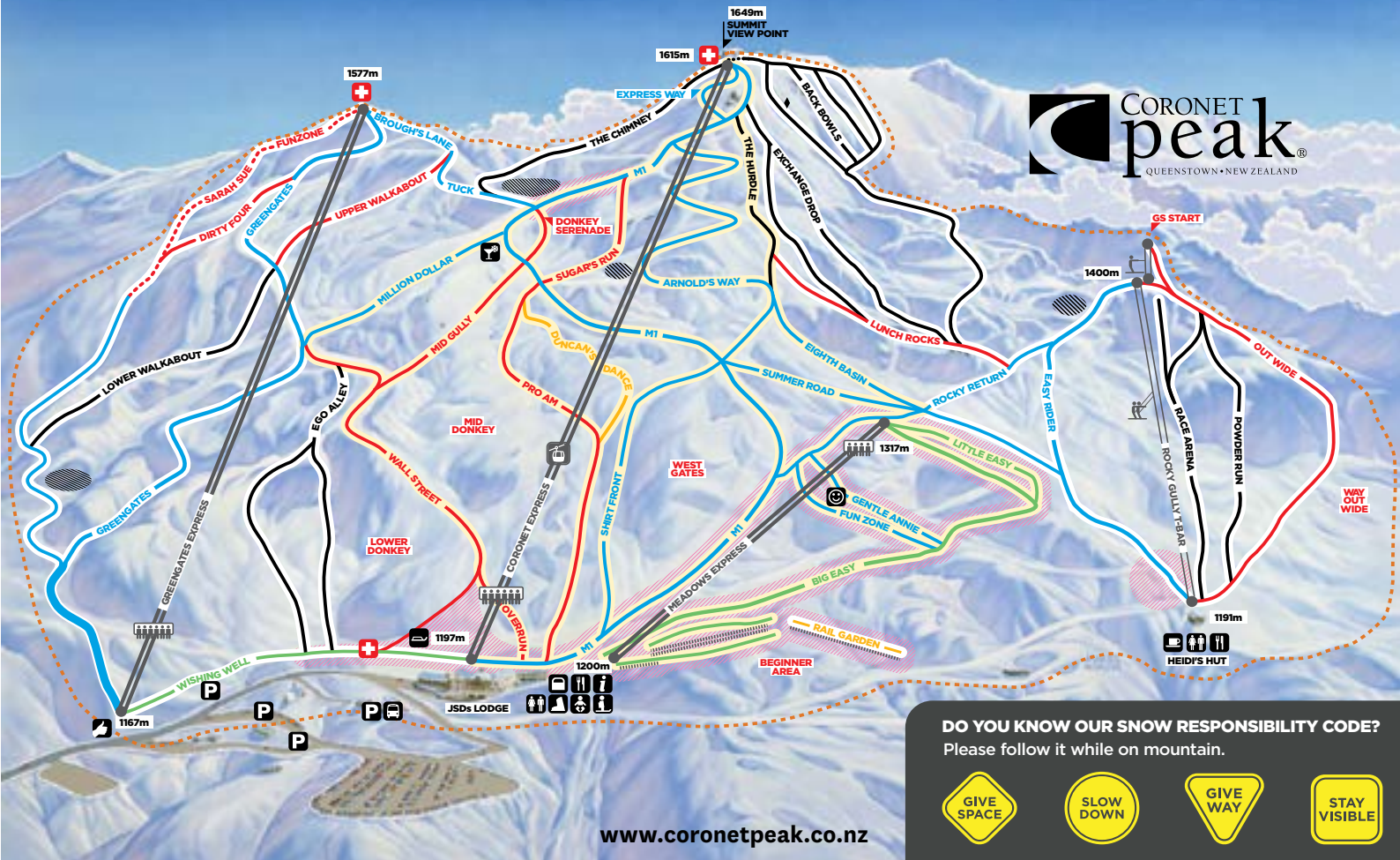

TOP TIPS

- Hire equipment on-mountain to allow for changes and upgrades at any time, plus free overnight storage. Return at Coronet Peak, The Remarkables or The Station Building in Queenstown.
- Shuttle busses depart every 30 minutes or when full. Pre-booking for a specific date and time is required.
- First Tracks runs 8-9am (3 June – 17 September). Night Ski operates 4-9pm every Wednesday and Friday as well as on Saturdays during the July school holidays.

LIFT PASSES

Book before April for early bird specials on multi-day passes

MYPASS is a lift pass to ski and snowboard at Coronet Peak, The Remarkables and Mt Hutt ski fields. It can also be loaded with shuttle bus tickets and MYPASS money to use as an on-mountain debit card, so it's the only card you need.

Queenstown Superpass

All adult and child full-day lift passes are Superpasses excluding Earlybird Multiday passes and packaged products. A Superpass allows you to ski and ride on Coronet Peak, The Remarkables and Mt Hutt, as well as giving full flexibility for those days spent off the mountain. To redeem your Superpass, present your MyPass card at any participating business and your credit will automatically be deducted from the total amount to pay.

One adult Superpass equals \$95 credit at participating retail, restaurant and bar partners or \$100 credit at participating activity partners.

One child (6-15) Superpass equals \$50 credit at participating retail, restaurant and bar partners or \$55 credit at participating activity partners. A child is defined by each operator. All figures include GST.

STANDARD PACKAGES AVAILABLE

- First Timer Package:** One day pass includes learners lift pass, rentals and all day group lesson.
- Intro to Snow:** Three day pass including rental equipment. First day is a first timer pass including a learners pass and group lesson. Days 2 & 3 is an all mountain pass plus group lesson.
- Premium private:** Includes a performance all day private lesson, wiggley room access and served lunch. Guests must purchase lift pass and rentals additionally. Available for guests of all ability levels in groups of 1-4. Lesson is 9am-3.30pm from a high level instructor. \$949 for all day private lesson for 1-6 people. Lift passes and rentals not included and must be purchased separately.
