LIFT PASSES

Treble Cone passes are available in single or multi-day options to suit any holiday lengths. Order online and collect from our Pick Up Kiosks in Wānaka, Queenstown and on the mountain.

Lift passes will be dated. Multi-day passes are date and mountain specific and must be used within a specific window of time:

- 2 out of 3 days
- 3 out of 5 days
- 4 out of 7 days
- 5 out of 8 days
- 6 out of 9 days
- 7 out of 11 days

Excellent restaurants, cafes, wineries, breweries and an artisan distillery, Wānaka offers more choice than you'd expect from a town this size.

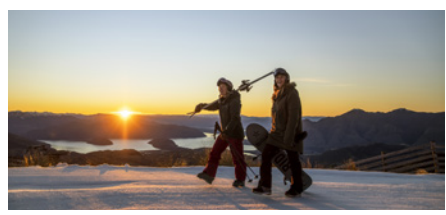
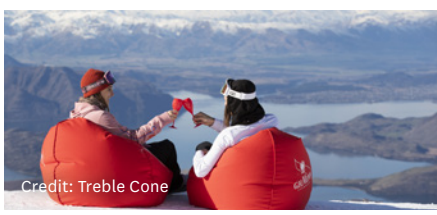
